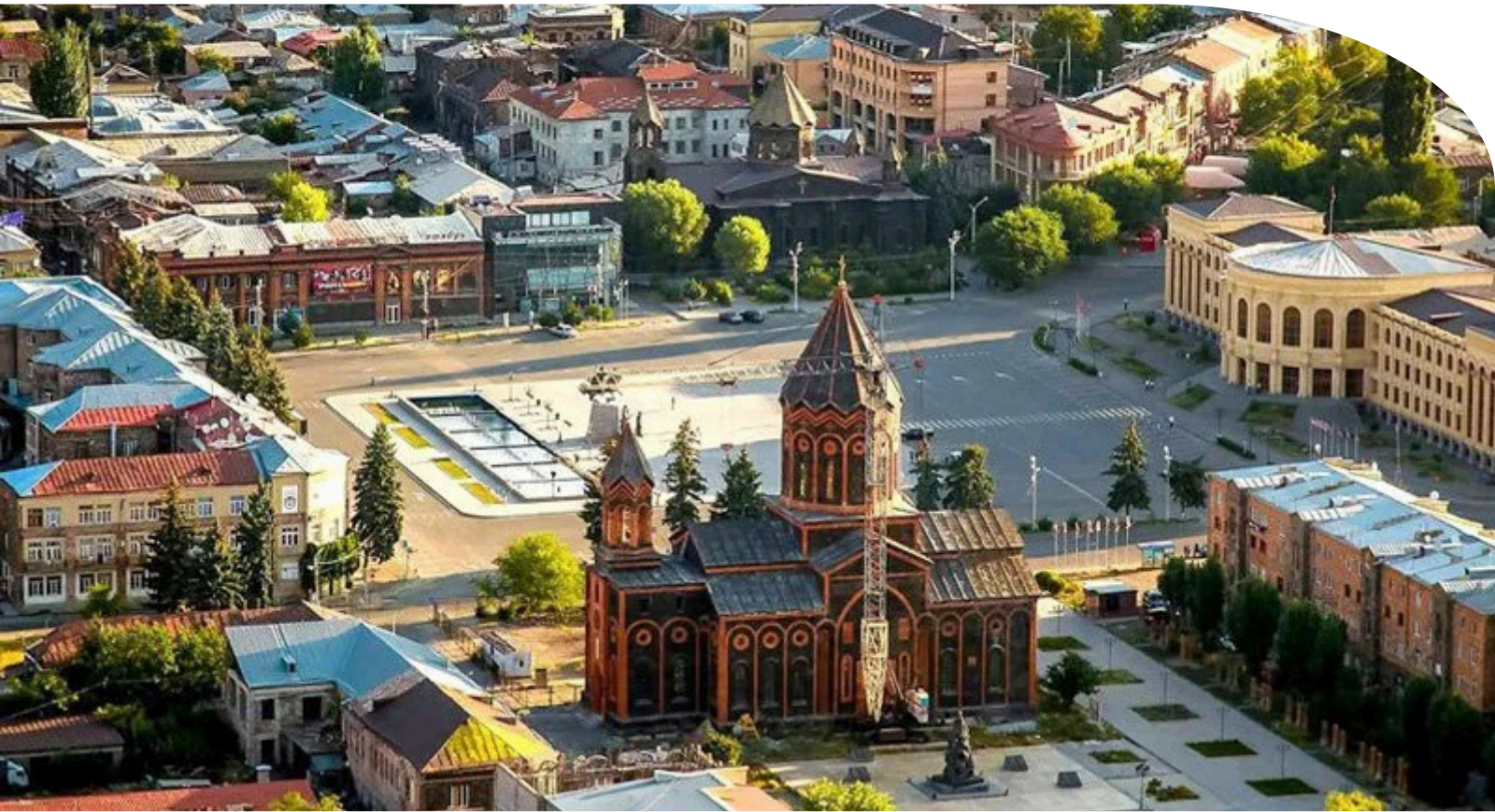

Welcome to Armenia. Welcome to Gyumri!


Useful Tips for Visitors
